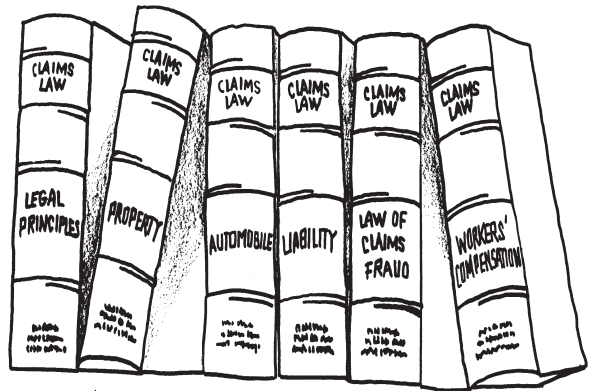

Claims Law Courses for Wyoming Continuing Education Credits
